
WILKPEX 2024:

Zunks information and examples needed:

The International Order of Zunks was formed in the Pittsburgh area in 1939, and over the next 6 years released over 75 Zunks cacheted covers marking holidays, Zunks anniversaries, and special events in the progress of WW II. Peter Martin (publisher of LaPosta journal of postal history, and I are gathering information about the Zunks (formation, operation, membership, and seeming dissolution when the war ended), and to pin down all the covers produced.

We think that WSC members might have information and examples of the covers since you are close to ground zero. Our object is to produce a monograph/catalog on the subjects, and name credit will be given for everyone who can help. Ukrainian Christmas Stamp 2023

On Dec 6, 2023, Ukraine's post office issued a pane of 5 semipostal stamps to mark St. Nicholas Day and the Day of the Armed Forces of Ukraine, both of which occurred on Dec. 6. Ukrainian artist Kostya Lavra designed the stamp, which combined elements of the St Nicholas tradition with elements of the armed forces. St. Nicholas carries a sack of gifts. However, the sack is camouflaged and the gifts spilling out consist of a tank, missile and aircraft.

St. Nicholas rides on the back of a horse that tramples over a double-headed eagle, a prominent figure on Russia's coat of arms. An imperial crown and orb, also elements of the Russian coat of arms, appear below the horse's raised tail.

In the traditions of many cultures, including Ukraine, St. Nicholas brings presents during the night for children to receive in the morning of December 6th.

The real St. Nicholas, from whom Santa Claus is derived, served as a bishop in the maritime city of Myra (modern day Demre, Turkey) during the fourth century and was known for his habit of gift giving.

Ukraine celebrates the Day of the Armed Forces of Ukraine on December 6th. Ukraine established its current form of armed forces on December 6, 1991. The date also marks the start of the first Winter Campaign in 1919, when the Ukrainian People's Republic faced the Bolsheviks in Ukraine during the Soviet-Ukrainian War.

The stamp is non-denominated. The rate, represented by the letter "M" is for a letter weighing up to 50 grams sent within Ukraine, currently 18 hryvnia. The surtax adds 5h to be donated to the Armed Forces of Ukraine. The pane, with the selvage showing an idealistic Ukrainian village in the snow, is available on their online postal shop https://postmark.ukrposhta.ua.
